MEMBERSHIP

1. All adults professing Islamic Faith and believing in the Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.), being the last Messenger of Allah, shall be eligible for membership.

Exclusion from membership

2. As one of the main objects of the Mosque is to promote the teachings of the Holy Quran and Hadith in accordance with the belief of Ahl-i-Sunnat wa Aljamaat (followers of Imam Azam, Imam Malik, Imam Shafi and Imam Ahmad bin Hambal), those belonging to Qadiani, Mirzai, Ishna-asharia, Shia or Ismaili schools of thought or belief, would not be eligible for membership.

3. The membership shall be open to all Muslims (as in Rule 7), residing in the Royal Borough of Kingston Upon Thames.

Qualifying period for membership

4. The qualifying period for membership shall be three months, during which period the member will not be entitled to attend the Annual General Meetings and will not be able to cast his vote during the election of the Council (Executive Committee).

Subscription

5. The annual subscription for membership is £20 (twenty pounds) with a joining fee of £10 (ten pounds) which is subject to review and shall fall due on 1st of April each year. Members whose subscriptions are in arrears for more than two months from the day it falls due, shall be excluded from their right to attend the Annual General Meeting and their right to vote shall be suspended. In cases where the subscription remains in arrears for more than three months, they shall cease to be members and their names will be removed from the register. Such members may, however, be re-enrolled on payment of arrears and a re-admission fee of £10 (ten pounds).
